

# 2010 INFORMATION CLINIC RIDERS & DEMO HORSES



**Deadline: February 22, 2010**

Midwest Horse Fair® is again offering several opportunities to participate with our clinicians. While many of the clinicians who are featured use their own horses in their training clinics/demonstrations, several clinicians accept “outside” horses and riders for some or all of their sessions. Please review the following information and complete application by the deadline to have your horse considered.

- Fees: Participation fee is \$125\* for each clinic/demo. The fee includes one stall and one weekend admission. **Payment is due only if you are accepted.**
- You will be notified no later than March 15, 2010 by the Midwest Horse Fair® office if your application is accepted. Once accepted you will be given additional forms and details.
- Please note that a video is required by some clinicians.
- Clinics are designed to cater to a broad spectrum of horsemen and women. Some clinicians are seeking equestrian competitors with specific skills; others are seeking any rider interested in improving their relationships with their horses. Do not hesitate to apply because you might not be selected – you may be just what the clinician is looking for!
- Keep in mind that clinics will be conducted in areas where there are likely to be large crowds in attendance. Opportunities to warm up in the actual arena may not be available. Please do not apply if you and/or your horse cannot function in such a setting.

To apply, fill out the following application and be sure to attach a brief explanation and description of training history, style of riding, where you've ridden, competition level (if applicable) and a little bit about yourself. - o Horse photo and owners description of the issues they wish to address must be submitted additionally
- o Horses must be at least 4 yrs. old, well trained under saddle and have gait issues NOT behavioral problems **No stallions allowed**

- o Non-pro reining horse with potential to improve skills, video required of 1 run **on horse you would bring.**

- o Carriage Driven horses that are driven safely & can stand quietly
- o Drivers at novice whip level and also drivers looking to improve their performance

- o Barefoot Horse

- o Requests advanced to upper level dressage riders
- o 5-10 min. video must be submitted of test or competition participated in or school video showing walk-trot-canter

**Donna Snyder-Smith**

- o Riders with horses who have done some endurance or competitive trail riding
- o Hunter seat, Reining, Dressage & Western Pleasure horses looking to learn correct basics
